



2018 - 2019 FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION INFORMATION

One of the many goals of the SA City SC is to ensure as many players as possible with the desire, commitment and ability to play select soccer be given the opportunity, regardless of financial ability. We have created the Players Foundation to aid in addressing the financial needs of our players.

All of the following are REQUIRED in the financial aid process:

The following are NOT covered by Financial Aid and MUST be paid by each player:

- *Deposit Fee \$300.00*
- *Purchase of Full Required Uniform Package*
- *Team Tournament Fees for each tournament*
- *Staff Travel Expenses- divided by team for trainer expenses for all out of town tournaments, showcases, etc.*
- *Additional Fees if Applicable determined per team as designated by director/coach to be collected by team manager from players*
- *Individual Travel Expenses for season and tournaments – Hotel, Gas, & Meals – for player and/ or family*

SA City SC reserves the right to deny any application received after the above deadlines and that not everyone who applies will be eligible for a Financial Aid award.

Financial Aid awards are not talent-based but are based on financial need using the Federal Poverty Guidelines as a tool. Financial Aid awards are reviewed by the Financial Aid Committee and not our coaching staff. Once your paperwork has been reviewed, you will be notified by mail or email if approved or denied within 2 weeks if turned in by the deadline. Again, requests for financial assistance can be approved or denied based on criteria above.

Financial Aid Deadlines and Volunteer Hours

ALL FINANCIAL AID APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN LISTED DATES for the following year of eligibility:

In order to receive prior to tryouts: Application must be received no later than
May 10th, 2018 for '08 - '07 players
May 19th 2018 for '06 – '00 players

FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES MAY RESULT IN THE FORFEITURE OF THE FINANCIAL AID AWARD:

Each family awarded Financial Aid must:

- Meet and adhere to all guidelines set forth in the Player Commitment document.
- Demonstrate dedication through consistent attendance at team practices and games.
- Be available to support tournaments and events that SA City SC sponsors or co-sponsors.
- Remain in good financial standing (payments are constant and on time)
- Demonstrate active participation in the club and its team activities by volunteering the minimum required hours

ALL FINANCIAL AID RECIPIENTS APPLICATIONS MUST COMPLETE VOLUNTEER HOURS (Per Player):

- 25% = 5 hrs per recipient
- 50% = 7.5 hrs per recipient
- 75% = 10 hrs per recipient
- 100% 12.5 hrs per recipient

All hours will be documented and put in your financial aid folder. If you are up for review of financial aid in the next calendar year, hours will be noted as complete or incomplete. Completion of hours is directly related to financial aid distribution on an annual basis.
