Please complete the following required steps for completion of registration.

REGISTRATION:

Registrations for SA City SC use a program called Got Soccer. Initially you will need to create a username and password. This account will have all of your family information for future registrations. An account needs to be created for each player in order to register for age appropriate program.

ALL BELOW DOCUMENTS NEED TO BE UPLOADED IN YOUR CHILD'S GOT SOCCER ACCOUNT.

PAPERWORK:

In your player Got Soccer account, we need the 4 items below uploaded. Instruction sheets are available upon request.

If you have already uploaded into your player's account, you do not need to re-submit annually:

- 1) Birth Certificate
- 2) Photo (headshot only please- passport style neck up)

Annual documents – please upload:

- 3) US Club Form
- 4) USYS Medical Release

- 1) Commitment Fee -\$250.00 fee in your player's Got Soccer account.
- 2) Set up credit card in your Got Soccer account for the remainder of your fees. You can pay in full or set up 8 payments in Got Soccer. Instructions are available on request.

In Got Soccer, once all paperwork is uploaded, commitment fees paid, and billing has been set up, your assigned roster spot is reserved for the 2018-2019 season. Soon to follow you will get a uniform link from soccer.com to order your new 2 year kit. Please order with 2 years in mind for sizing in order to not need to repurchase next year

2018-2019 '08 & '07 Player Commitment Agreement

Welcome to the SA City SC (Formerly known as Lonestar SC SA) '08/07 age Player Placement Events (PPE). We are excited you made the choice to come and participate in our PPE (tryouts for new players) for the 2018-2019 soccer season.

With the guidance of our Director of Coaching, Nick Hallam, we believe our staff is the strongest in San Antonio. SA City SC brings a quality of training focused on player development and club wide playing style to your player that is second to none! After the Player Placement Event we will hold team meetings for players placed on teams. You will complete any outstanding registration and commitments needs, meet your player's coach, and have the opportunity to ask questions.

Important Information:

I/We understand that this commitment is for the Fall 2018 through Spring 2019. Application is hereby made for registration of a player as a member of the SA City SC for the 2018-2019 soccer year. This is to include any scrimmages, games, tournaments, and/or showcases the team participates in throughout the entire season (August through June).

I/We understand that the selection and team placement of players shall be at the sole and absolute discretion of the SA City SC coaching staff. The continued participation of a player is contingent upon the player and family abiding by the rules, agreements, and policies (including Parent and Player guidelines and responsibilities found in the Player & Parent Handbook, online), the Alamo Area Youth Soccer Association (AAYSA), Western District Division One Association (WDDOA), the South Texas Youth Soccer Association (STYSA), the United States Soccer Federation (USSF), SRPL, Super Y League, the Elite Clubs National League (ECNL), and US Club Soccer.

Any player rostered to a SA City SC team is considered by the club a SA City SC player throughout the year. If the coaching staff feels movement between teams is necessary to benefit the overall development of the player, team, and club, such movement between teams can be initiated by the coaching staff anytime the rosters are open and league rules permit player movement. Players have the right to refuse to move, although doing so and going against the qualified guidance of the SA City SC coaching staff is not encouraged.

Player/Parent Handbook:

The Player/Parent Handbook is found online on our website. It contains all information regarding SA City SC policies and procedures. All players and their families are expected to abide by and support the policies and procedures included therein. For additional questions please follow the communication channels identified in the handbook and contact your team coach, program director, or the administrative office.

Important Pre-Season Fall 2018

- Pre-season training: Sessions August 4th & 5th OR August 6th, 7th, and 8th
- Regular training begins: Monday, August 13th or Tuesday, August 14th (all teams)
- Possible tournament: August 18th or 19th (DOC sets schedules)
- Possible Club Day: August 18th or 19th (DOC sets schedules)
- Possible tournament: August 25th and 26th (DOC sets schedules)
- Austin Labor Day Cup (ALDC): September 1st - 3rd

Expectations and Requirements:

All players are expected to meet a high standard of commitment. Players are expected to attend all practices and participate in all league games and tournaments scheduled for their assigned team. SRPL, USC, Super Y League, Division I, Super II, and Division II coaches will make every effort to play each player at least 50% of each game, except when players are injured, ill, and ineligible because of an overdue fee balance, or attendance or disciplinary reasons.

Players should expect to play in several tournaments on weekends and holidays including; Fall Warm Up (Aug), Labor Day (Sept), Thanksgiving (Nov), Winter Tournament (Dec), Spring Warm Up (Feb), Memorial Day (May), older team showcase (June), and/or others. Your team's actual tournament attendance is dependent on appropriate bracket availability and staff availability (with multiple teams). Some team assignments may not be identical to other SA City SC teams.

Tournament fees are not included in the annual registration fees as they vary from one team to another. These fees are collected by the team managers as they register for them throughout the year. Amount of tournament (and possible trainer travel fee if an out of town event) is calculated and divided by the number of players on the team. Players are required, as a player on the roster, to pay for their portion of tournament and any travel fees for trainers the team is attending. Payment is due for a tournament regardless of participation on these as they are required tournaments. Tournaments are determined by the director of the program.

Annual Fees:

Annual fees include all practice fees, all player related registration into the appropriate registrations, league team registrations for Fall and Spring, Spring team cup registrations, etc. Additional costs include, but may not be limited to, pre/post season tournament fees (determined by SA City SC & Coaching Staff), player travel expenses, team fees, and out- of-San Antonio team travel costs for SA City SC coaches at these events. Fees remain the same regardless of the number of days in the season. During the season if the player’s division status changes, *fees will be adjusted accordingly*. Fees will not be refunded or forgiven due to player absences, withdrawals, or early release from a team. Fees will not be refunded if injured – however, if communication is made to our administration and it is determined an injury which will enable a player for several months, adjusted amount may be used at a return date after injury. If billing has started and a team should move within divisions or associations, prices will be adjusted to the remainder of the payments for the adjusted amount.

Initial Commitment fee is \$250.00 (non-refundable) collected during Player Placement Event for all players to secure their spot and hold their place on the team.

Payment Schedule:

1. The first payment required upon placement/commitment to a team will be \$250 payable at sign-up. *This payment is non-refundable and non-transferable.*
2. The \$250 is deducted from the annual fees once paid. If you choose not to pay the balance in full, fees will then be payable over 8 months due July 15th through February 15th.
3. The Annual Fee covers the period right after Player Placement Event to the end of Spring events 2019.
4. Players who pay in full (full tuition) by June 30th will receive a discount of \$75.

Payment Penalties:

- A \$25 fee will be charged for any non-sufficient funds check or declined credit/debit card.
- Monthly fees are considered late if not received in the office by the 30th of each month. Failure to pay your monthly fees within thirty (30) days of fee payment due date will invoke the “NO PAY- NO PLAY” Club Disciplinary Policy. Players will not be eligible to participate in team practices, games, and tournaments until payment issues are resolved.
- SACSC allows 8 months for the completion of payment for our Select Programs. If extensions are needed, communication must be made immediately and prior to any late payment with kstoddard@sacitysc.com. If payments exceed the 8 month time period, and no communication has been made to extend further than the 8 month period, a \$25 late fee will be added to your payment(s) per month if payments exceed the 8 month time period for payment.

Financial Assistance:

The Financial Aid Application is due by May 10, 2018 for '08 & '07. A written decision will be mailed/emailed from the Financial Aid Committee prior to the July payment due date. Payment of the \$300 commitment fee is **required** at the time of signing. The commitment fee and uniform fee cannot be included in financial aid considerations. Pay In Full discounts do not apply to participants of Financial Assistance.
